### Summer Camps

Once again, McMaster's popular summer camp programs will begin on July 4. Each year several thousand children from across Hamilton attend sports, educational and recreation camps on campus.

A few reminders:

- A Hamilton Police Services officer will be stationed each morning at the Sterling Street entrance to ensure efficient traffic flow
- · Parents will be directed to the appropriate drop-off and pick-up locations on campus
- · Camp buses will use the Main Street entrance to drop off and pick up children
- Parents have been directed to enter campus at Sterling Street and not to park or stop on Mayfair or Forsyth

Summer camps operate in two-week cycles. Experience has shown that it may take a few days at the beginning of each cycle for parents to familiarize themselves with the parking and traffic routing. As always, your patience is greatly appreciated as we work to ensure a successful and safe camp season for all involved.

#### Campus farmer's market

The mini farmer's market established on campus last year will once again be operational this summer and fall. The not-for-profit market, run by volunteers, is scheduled to open in mid-July and, depending on the growing season, will run until mid-October. Farm produce will be delivered to the oval in front of University Hall. Produce for sale will vary but will include fruit, vegetables and preserves. Recipes will be available, as will information on the importance of supporting locally-grown food.
