EQAO RESULTS Wards 1 and 2 Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board Judith Bishop 2013

This year there were again improved results in many schools. Congratulations to everyone!

At Grade 3, three out of the 9 schools had more students at levels 3 and 4 for math, three out of the 9 schools for reading, and five out of the 9 schools for writing than last year. Strathcona improved in all three areas, and three schools, Bennetto, Earl Kitchener and Prince Philip, improved in two areas. However there were two schools where all results were lower than the year before. Some of the results showed substantial increases:

- **Prince Philip** increased by 20% in math
- **Bennetto** increased by 9% in math
- Earl Kitchener increased by 13% in reading and 5% in writing
- Strathcona increased by 5% in math, 6% in reading, and 14% in writing.

At Grade 6, two out of the 6 schools had more students at levels 3 and 4 for reading, three out of 6 schools for writing, and three schools improved for math. Queen Victoria improved in all three areas. Ryerson improved in reading and writing. Some of the results were again substantial increases on last year's results.

- **Dr. Davey** increased by 9% in math
- Queen Victoria increased 4% in reading, 9% in writing and 6% in math
- **Dalewood** increased by 8% in math
- **Bennetto** increased by 18% in writing
- **Rverson** increased 4% in reading, 4% in writing,

Board Profile

This year the EQAO office reports that Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board is once again above the provincial average for the percentage of **English Language Learners**.

- 21% of grade 3 students are English Language learners in Hamilton, compared to 13% in the Province and only 3% in the Catholic Board.
- In grade 6 the percentages are 17% for HWDSB, 9% for the Province, and 4% for the Catholic Board.

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board also has a higher percentage of **special education students**:

- 20% in grade 3 compared to 17% for the Province and 12% for the Catholic board.
- 25% in grade 6 compared to 20 % for the Province and 16% for the Catholic board

The Education Quality Assessment Organisation (EQAO) tests are Provincial tests that began in 1998 and are based on the Ontario Curriculum. The Ontario Curriculum was introduced in 1997.
